Iraq

Introduction

1. Council Regulation (EC) 1210/2003 ("the Regulation") imposing financial sanctions against Iraq has been amended so that an asset freeze no longer applies to the person listed in the Annex to this Notice.

Notice summary (Full details are provided in the Annex to this Notice)

- 2. The following entry has been <u>removed</u> from the consolidated list and is no longer subject to an asset freeze.
 - MAYSAN SUGAR STATE ENTERPRISE (Group ID: 8126)

Legislative details

- On 8 November 2018 Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2018/1661 ("the Amending Regulation") was published in the Official Journal of the European Union (O.J. L 278, 8.11.2018, p.16) by the European Commission.
- 4. The Amending Regulation amended Annex III to the Regulation with effect from 9 November 2018.
- The Amending Regulation reflects the decision made on 2 November 2018 by the United Nations Security Council (UNSC) Committee established pursuant to Resolutions 1518 (2003) and 1483 (2003) remove 1 entity from the UN Iraq list.
