

Financial Sanctions Notice

29/10/2018

Republic of Guinea

Introduction

- 1. Council Regulation (EU) 1284/2009 ("the Regulation") imposing financial sanctions against the Republic of Guinea.
- 2. Identifying information for the individuals listed in the Annex to this Notice has been amended.

Notice summary (Full details are provided in the Annex to this Notice)

3. The entries detailed in the Annex to the Notice have been <u>amended</u> and are still subject to an asset freeze.

What <u>you</u> must do

- 4. You must:
 - i. check whether you maintain any accounts or hold any funds or economic resources for the persons set out in the Annex to this Notice;
 - ii. freeze such accounts, and other funds or economic resources;
 - iii. refrain from dealing with the funds or assets or making them available (directly or indirectly) to such persons unless licensed by the Office of Financial Sanctions Implementation (OFSI);
 - iv. report any findings to OFSI, together with any additional information that would facilitate compliance with the Regulation;

- v. provide any information concerning the frozen assets of designated persons that OFSI may request. Information reported to OFSI may be passed on to other regulatory authorities or law enforcement.
- 5. Where a relevant institution has <u>already reported</u> details of accounts, other funds or economic resources held frozen for designated persons, <u>they are not required to report</u> <u>these details again</u>.
- 6. Failure to comply with financial sanctions legislation or to seek to circumvent its provisions is a criminal offence.

Legislative details

- On 26 October 2018 Council Implementing Regulation (EU) No 2018/1604 ("the Amending Regulation") was published in the Official Journal of the European Union (O.J. L 268, 26.10.2018, p.16) by the Council of the European Union.
- 8. The Amending Regulation amended Annex II to the Regulation with effect from 27 October 2018.
