

# **Financial Sanctions Notice**

15/03/2019

# **Ukraine (Sovereignty and Territorial Integrity)**

#### Introduction

1. Council Regulation (EU) 269/2014 ("the Regulation") imposing financial sanctions against those undermining or threatening the sovereignty and territorial integrity of Ukraine has been amended so that an asset freeze now applies to the persons listed in the Annex to this Notice.

# Notice summary (Full details are provided in the Annex to this Notice)

2. The entries detailed in the Annex to this notice have been <u>added</u> to the consolidated list and are now subject to an asset freeze.

#### What you must do

#### 3. You must:

- i. check whether you maintain any accounts or hold any funds or economic resources for the persons set out in the Annex to this Notice;
- ii. freeze such accounts, and other funds or economic resources;
- refrain from dealing with the funds or assets or making them available (directly or indirectly) to such persons unless licensed by the Office of Financial Sanctions Implementation (OFSI);
- iv. report any findings to OFSI, together with any additional information that would facilitate compliance with the Regulation;

- v. provide any information concerning the frozen assets of designated persons that OFSI may request. Information reported to OFSI may be passed on to other regulatory authorities or law enforcement.
- 4. Failure to comply with financial sanctions legislation or to seek to circumvent its provisions is a criminal offence.

# Legislative details

- 5. On 15 March 2019 Council Implementing Regulation (EU) 2019/409 ("the Amending Regulation") was published in the Official Journal of the European Union (O.J. L 73, 15.3.2019, p.16) by the Council of the European Union.
- 6. The Amending Regulation amended Annex I to the Regulation with effect from 15 March 2019.
