Mali

Introduction

1. Council Regulation (EU) 2017/1770 ("the Regulation") imposing financial sanctions with regard to Mali has been amended.

Notice summary (Full details are provided in the Annex to this Notice)

- 2. The following entries have been <u>amended</u> and are still subject to an asset freeze:
 - Ahmed AG ALBACHAR (Group ID: 13799)
 - Houka Houka AG ALHOUSSEINI (Group ID: 13800)
 - Mahri Sidi Amar BEN DAHA (Group ID: 13801)
 - Mohamed Ben Ahmed MAHRI (Group ID: 13802)
 - Mohamed Ould MATALY (Group ID: 13803)

What you must do

- 3. You must:
 - check whether you maintain any accounts or hold any funds or economic resources for the persons set out in the Annex to this Notice;
 - ii. freeze such accounts, and other funds or economic resources;
 - iii. refrain from dealing with the funds or assets or making them available (directly or

- indirectly) to such persons unless licensed by the Office of Financial Sanctions Implementation (OFSI);
- iv. report any findings to OFSI, together with any additional information that would facilitate compliance with the Regulation;
- v. provide any information concerning the frozen assets of designated persons that OFSI may request. Information reported to OFSI may be passed on to other regulatory authorities or law enforcement.
- 4. Where a relevant institution has <u>already reported</u> details of accounts, other funds or economic resources held frozen for designated persons, <u>they are not required to report these details again</u>.
- 5. Failure to comply with financial sanctions legislation or to seek to circumvent its provisions is a criminal offence.

Legislative details

- 6. On 8 January 2020 Council Implementing Regulation (EU) 2020/8 ("the Amending Regulation") was published in the Official Journal of the European Union (O.J. L 4 I, 8.1.2020, p.1) by the Council of the European Union.
- 7. The Amending Regulation amended Annex I to the Regulation with effect from 8 January 2020.
- 8. The Amending Regulation reflects the decisions made on 19 December 2019 by the United Nations Security Council (UNSC) Committee established pursuant to Resolutions 2374 (2017) and 2432 (2018) to add 5 individuals to the UN Mali list.
- 9. In accordance with the United Nations and European Union Financial Sanctions (Linking) Regulations 2017 made under the Policing and Crime Act 2017, the UK enacted this decision on 20 December 2019 and issued Notice 'HM Treasury notice, 20/12/2019, Mali' (https://assets.publishing.service.gov.uk/government/uploads/system/uploads/attachme nt_data/file/854597/Notice Mali UN_without_delay_201219.pdf).
- 10. This EU Amending Notice supersedes that Notice.
