

Financial Sanctions Notice

17/04/2020

Iran (human rights)

Introduction

1. This notice is to issue a correction relating to the Iran (human rights) financial sanctions regime.

Notice summary (Full details are provided in the Annex to this Notice)

- 2. The following entries have been <u>amended</u> and are still subject to an asset freeze:
 - Mohammad HOSSEINI (Group ID: 12201)
 - Ali Ashraf RASHIDI AGHDAM (Group ID: 12849)
 - Hossein TAEB (Group ID: 11788)
 - CYBER POLICE (Group ID: 12864)

What you must do

3. You must:

- i. check whether you maintain any accounts or hold any funds or economic resources for the persons set out in the Annex to this Notice;
- ii. freeze such accounts, and other funds or economic resources;
- refrain from dealing with the funds or assets or making them available (directly or indirectly) to such persons unless licensed by the Office of Financial Sanctions Implementation (OFSI);

- iv. report any findings to OFSI, together with any additional information that would facilitate compliance with the Regulation;
- v. provide any information concerning the frozen assets of designated persons that OFSI may request. Information reported to OFSI may be passed on to other regulatory authorities or law enforcement.
- 4. Where a relevant institution has <u>already reported</u> details of accounts, other funds or economic resources held frozen for designated persons, <u>they are not required to report these details again</u>.
- 5. Failure to comply with financial sanctions legislation or to seek to circumvent its provisions is a criminal offence.

Legislative details

- 6. On 8 April 2020 Council Implementing Regulation (EU) 2020/510 ("the Amending Regulation") was published in the Official Journal of the European Union (O.J. L 113, 8.4.2020, p.1) by the Council of the European Union.
- 7. The Amending Regulation amended Annex I to Council Regulation (EU) 359/2011 with effect from 8 April 2020.
