

Financial Sanctions Notice

Central African Republic

Introduction

1. The United Nations Security Council's sanctions list has been updated.

Notice summary (Full details are provided in the Annex to this Notice)

- By virtue of the United Nations and European Union Financial Sanctions (Linking) Regulations 2017, the following entry has been <u>added</u> to the consolidated list and is now subject to an asset freeze.
 - Martin KOUMTAMADJI (Group ID: 13833) (the "DP")

Legislative Details

- 3. On 20 April 2020, the United Nations Security Council Committee established by Resolution 2127 (2013) concerning the Central African Republic approved the addition of 1 entry to its list of individuals and entities subject to an asset freeze.
- 4. Unless the DP is listed under EU Regulation 224/2014 by 20 May 2020, the asset freeze will cease to apply from 11:59 p.m. on 20 May 2020 until the date upon which the DP is listed by the EU.

What <u>you</u> must do

- 5. You must:
 - i. check whether you maintain any accounts or hold any funds or economic resources for the persons set out in the Annex to this Notice;
 - ii. freeze such accounts, and other funds or economic resources;
 - iii. refrain from dealing with the funds or assets or making them available (directly or indirectly) to such persons unless licensed by the Office of Financial Sanctions Implementation (OFSI);
 - iv. report any findings to OFSI, together with any additional information that would facilitate compliance with the Regulation;
 - v. provide any information concerning the frozen assets of designated persons that OFSI may request. Information reported to OFSI may be passed on to other regulatory authorities or law enforcement.
- 6. Failure to comply with financial sanctions legislation or seeking to circumvent its provisions is a criminal offence.
