Ukraine (Sovereignty and Territorial Integrity)

Introduction

- 1. Council Regulation (EU) 269/2014 ("the Regulation") imposing financial sanctions against those undermining or threatening the sovereignty and territorial integrity of Ukraine has been amended.
- 2. Identifying information for the individuals and entities listed in the Annex to this Notice has been amended.

Notice summary (Full details are provided in the Annex to this Notice)

3. 69 entries have been <u>amended</u> and are still subject to an asset freeze:

What you must do

- 4. You must:
 - i. check whether you maintain any accounts or hold any funds or economic resources for the persons set out in the Annex to this Notice;
 - ii. freeze such accounts, and other funds or economic resources;
 - iii. refrain from dealing with the funds or assets or making them available (directly or indirectly) to such persons unless licensed by the Office of Financial Sanctions Implementation (OFSI);
 - iv. report any findings to OFSI, together with any additional information that would facilitate compliance with the Regulation;

- v. provide any information concerning the frozen assets of designated persons that OFSI may request. Information reported to OFSI may be passed on to other regulatory authorities or law enforcement.
- 5. Where a relevant institution has <u>already reported</u> details of accounts, other funds or economic resources held frozen for designated persons, <u>they are not required to report</u> <u>these details again</u>.
- 6. Failure to comply with financial sanctions legislation or to seek to circumvent its provisions is a criminal offence.

Legislative details

- On 11 September 2020 Council Implementing Regulation (EU) 2020/1267 ("the Amending Regulation") was published in the Official Journal of the European Union (O.J. L 298, 11.9.2020, p.1) by the Council of the European Union.
- 8. The Amending Regulation amended Annex I to the Regulation with effect from 12 September 2020.

On 30 January 2015, Prime Minister Dmitry Medvedev signed a decree that awarded to Rotenberg's company, Stroygazmontazh, a State contract for the construction of the Kerch bridge from Russia to the illegally annexed Autonomous 'Republic of Crimea'. Through these contracts he has financially benefited from Russian decision-makers responsible for the annexation of Crimea or the destabilisation of eastern Ukraine. He is the Former owner of the Stroygazmontazh company which has been awarded State contracts for the construction of the Kerch bridge from Russia to the illegally annexed Autonomous 'Republic of Crimea'. In January 2017, Stroygazmontazh was awarded the State contract worth RUB 17 billion for the construction of a railway line on the Kerch bridge. Owner of two companies, Mostotrest and Stroygazmontazh-Most, designated for their activities undermining Ukrainian sovereignty. For his involvement in the construction of the Kerch bridge he was awarded with the State order 'Hero of Labour of the Russian Federation' in March 2020. He is the chairman of the board of directors of publishing house Prosvescheniye which has notably implemented a public relations campaign that was designed to persuade Crimean children that they are now Russian citizens living in Russia, and thereby supporting the Russian Government's policy to integrate Crimea into Russia.
